Sample contract for: Schoolwork & Recreational Reading

Rule 1: XXXX will do acceptable school work. He will also complete ALL DOL assignments. No report card/progress report grade lower than a "C" will be acceptable.

In order to ensure that XXXX is keeping up with all work, he will:

1. Write all daily assignments in his planner for each class, each day.
2. Have his English, Math, and Science teachers initial his planner each day.
3. Have ALL class grades recorded, and signed by a parent each day.
4. XXXX will be settled at the designated study table and begin doing homework by:
 - a. 5:00 pm on Monday and Tuesday
 - b. 6:30 pm on Wednesday and Thursday
 - c. 10:00 am on Saturday
5. XXXX will do NO recreational reading when he is supposed to be doing work at school or homework. This includes not reading when waiting for such things as the computer to boot.
6. XXXX will do no recreational reading, nor have recreational reading materials at church from the time he leaves the car until he returns to the car.

Rule 2: When XXXX is assigned chores or attends church he will not possess or use any recreational reading materials.

- a. Church: XXXX must leave all recreational reading materials in the car when he arrives at church.
- b. When XXXX goes out to eat with the family, he must leave all recreational materials in the car.
- c. When XXXX is assigned to a chore to complete, he will not use any recreational reading materials until the chore is completed.
- d. There may be other times XXXX is instructed not to use recreational reading materials.

Rule 3: From this point forward, XXXX will be responsible for purchasing his own recreational reading materials.

Consequences

1. Knowing that XXXX may not be able to pass _____ by the end of the first semester, the following will be expected: XXXX will noticeably improve all failing grades. XXXX will receive no additional failing class grades on his report card. If XXXX fails in either of these expectations, ALL recreational reading will be limited to 30 minutes prior to bed time, 7 days a week, until ALL grades are above failing.
2. If XXXX does not begin his homework at the designated time he will lose all recreational reading materials, including the newspaper, cereal boxes, etc., for 24 hours. On the next school day a note will be written in his planner stating that he will not be allowed to do any non-assigned reading for that day. The staff of after school programs will also be notified.
3. If it is found or reported that XXXX was reading recreational material during any of these prohibited times he will lose all recreational reading materials, including the newspaper, cereal boxes, etc., for 24 hours.
4. If XXXX is given this consequence and is found to have disobeyed the consequence, the consequence will be extended an additional 48 hours. XXXX will also lose all video game privileges during this period.

Rewards

1. If XXXX complies with the above rules, he will be allowed to do recreational reading at the appropriate times.
2. XXXX, and siblings will all be financially rewarded for report card grades as follows:
 - a. A's: \$20
 - b. B's: \$10
3. Each Sunday evening XXXX and his siblings will receive a weekly allowance of \$10. If during the previous 7 days XXXX violates Rules 1 or 2, or he or his siblings do not complete assigned chores, they will forfeit their \$10 allowance for that week.

Sample Contract for School Grades

RULE 1:XXXX will begin passing all classes with a 65 average or higher, by attending and being on time to all classes, will do all class work, and homework.

In order to monitor this and receive his rewards or face consequences XXXX will:

1. Bring will complete a daily progress report which Mom will design , and will have it completed and signed by the teacher before the end of each class. XXXX will fill out the homework section. The teacher will complete the behavior section, and will initial the report.
2. XXXX will be responsible to bring the daily report home give it to his mother, no matter how late she returns home. (5pm and 10:15pm are the expected times)

Reward

If XXXX does the following:

Has the daily progress report completely filled out, returned to mom each day, completes all assignments in class and at home, has no negative comments, and has no in or out of school suspensions he will receive \$2 of monopoly money for each day. If this is done for each day of the school week he will receive a BONUS of \$5 monopoly. All monopoly monies will be redeemed when Mom receives her paycheck. Once monopoly money is received it cannot be taken away for subsequent problem behaviors.

Consequence A

If XXXX does any of the following he will receive the consequence of providing one day (6 hours) of unpaid hard labor either for his mother, a needy home arranged through the church, or a volunteer organization approved by Mom:

- loses his daily progress report
- forges any signatures or information
- does not provide progress report to Mom
- doesn't complete assignments at least to a passing level
- receives negative comments from any classes
- is tardy, late, or unexcused absence
- gets suspended for any reason
- does not show Mom his homework
- doesn't complete school work when asked

Consequence B

If XXXX refuses to cooperate with Consequence A, he will have 1 hour added to the day of hard labor for each day he refuses Consequence A. Mom will also place a lock on XXXX's room. He will not be allowed into his room until he completes Consequence A. Mom will provide XXXX with any items from his room which she deems necessary. If XXXX attempts to gain entrance into the locked room, Mom will begin selling XXXX's belongings to pay for damage. Probation and law enforcement will be immediately notified if XXXX threatens, or becomes violent.
